Enclosed for filing on behalf of GTC, Inc. d/b/a FairPoint Communications is the following:

(1) Certification required in accordance with 47 C.F.R. §51.917(d)(vii), adopted by the Federal Communications Commission in its Report and Order WC Docket Nos. 10-90 et. al., FCC No. 11-161 (November 18, 2011). This rule requires rate of return carriers seeking revenue recovery to “annually certify as part of its tariff filings to the Commission [FCC] and to the relevant state commission that the carrier is not seeking duplicative recovery in the state jurisdiction for any Eligible Recovery subject to the recovery mechanism.” The attached Certification (Attachment 1) was included with the annual access filing submitted to the FCC on June 17, 2013 and is hereby submitted to the Commission in compliance with the FCC rules.



Attachment 2 hereto, which is being filed as confidential, includes the required data. The certifications related to this information are contained in Attachment 3.

(3) In compliance with 47 C.F.R. §54.313(h), which requires recipients of high-cost support to provide certain rate information that determines any applicable limitations on high cost support in accordance with §54.318 of the FCC rules, FairPoint confirms that all state rates were above the rate floor of \$14.
