Dear Natural Gas Customer:

Peoples Gas has valued your business over the years and we have been pleased to serve you.

As a result of an agreement made in the 1990's, Lake Apopka Natural Gas District has exercised an option to acquire certain gas facilities from Peoples Gas and that includes your natural gas service. Lake Apopka Natural Gas District will be your provider as soon as the purchase and sale of the gas facilities has been consummated. The purchase and sale will be consummated shortly after approval of a territorial agreement by the Florida Public Service Commission

Your meter(s) will be read on the day the sale is consummated, and Peoples Gas will mail you a statement for any amounts then due based on that meter reading. That will be the final bill from TECO Peoples Gas for natural gas service. Thereafter, your billing will come from the Lake Apopka Natural Gas District.

Once your final balance on the Peoples Gas statement has been paid, if you are due a refund of your account deposit, a check will be mailed to you at the address that we have on file.

If you have questions about your final TECO Peoples Gas statement, or any other matter concerning this transfer, please call our Customer Service group toll-free at (877) 832-6747.

Your first invoice as a new customer of the Lake Apopka Natural Gas District will include a deposit charge equal to the amount that was previously held by TECO Peoples Gas.

Lake Apopka Natural Gas District has agreed to apply the same rates as charged by TECO Peoples Gas through September 30, 2014, so you will not see a difference in rates.
