Audit staff has reviewed the Request for Confidentiality (04807-13) for **Exhibit A** (04808-13) and its companion justification matrix in **Exhibit C** (04807-13) submitted by Gulf Power Company (GPC) requesting an extension of confidential classification for the above-referenced information pursuant to §366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Specifically, the company has requested that certain portions of the report, as identified in **Exhibit C** (04807-13), be confidential under §366.093(3)(b) and (e), Florida Statutes. We concur.

Additionally, GPC has not requested confidential treatment of the remaining information in the original **Exhibit C** (08600-11). Therefore, this information is open to public disclosure.

In conclusion, audit staff requests that an order be issued to address the confidential classification requested for **Exhibit A** (04808-13) and the original audit report and workpapers (00049-12).
