

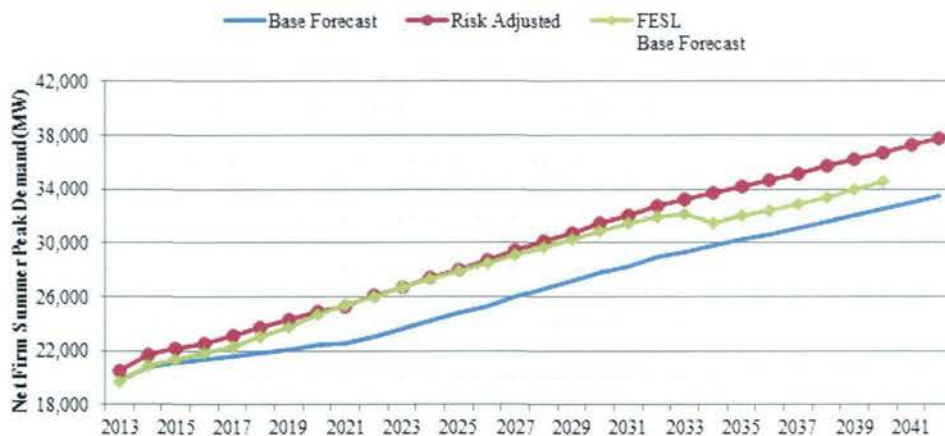

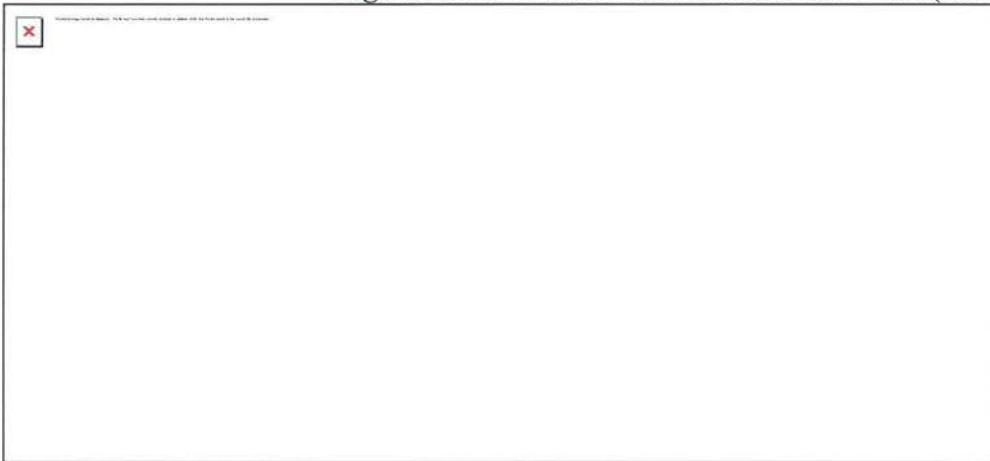

On Monday, 10/21, I received a letter from FPL correcting a previous data response which staff had relied upon in its recommendation. Staff would request permission to make an oral modification to the recommendation in order to provide accurate information to the Commissioners. **The modifications do not impact the overall recommendation from staff and are shown below in type and strike format.**

**Page 7, First full paragraph and revised Figure 1**

Overall, FPL's base case forecast ~~and risk-adjusted forecast~~ for summer peak demand ~~are is~~ down from ~~those~~ ~~that~~ presented in the FESL proceeding. As illustrated in Figure 1, the base case forecast for summer peak demand in 2017 is 7.4 percent lower than the risk-adjusted forecast and ~~25.5~~ 3.7 percent lower than the FESL forecast. By 2040, this gap increases to 13.0 percent for the risk-adjusted forecast and ~~28.4~~ 6.3 percent for the FESL forecast.
