2	CHAIRMAN E	BRISÉ:	Okay.	Seeing	none,	moving	on
3	to Item Number 11.	Thank	you very	much.			

MR. GARL: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. And good morning, Commissioners. I'm Steve Garl with Commission staff.

Item 11 is a petition from Peoples Gas System requesting approval of its Cast Iron/Bare Steel Pipe Replacement Rider surcharge for 2014. Peoples projects a 2014 revenue requirement of \$2.2 million in support of its pipe replacement program. This equates to a rider surcharge of 22 cents per month for residential customers using 20 therms per month.

Staff believes Peoples' calculation of the surcharge is reasonable and accurate, and therefore staff recommends approval.

CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: All right. Thank you very much.

Questions, Commissioners?

Commissioner Balbis.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

I have a couple of questions. And I fully supported the development of this rider previously, so I appreciate

Peoples Gas moving forward with it.

The question I have, and I don't know if it's

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appropriate for staff or for Peoples, is how many -- how
much remaining cast and bare steel pipeline will be in
the system after 2014? Like how much is left of
unprotected pipeline?

MS. FLOYD: Good morning. Kandi Floyd with Peoples Gas System.

Right now we project to have -- well, as of the end of this year we will have 330 miles of bare steel left to replace and approximately 90 miles of cast iron, and that will be beginning 2014.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. So at this accelerated rate of replacement when do you believe that Peoples will have removed all of this unprotected pipe from the system?

MS. FLOYD: Currently our projections are showing nine years. We originally looked at a ten-year replacement plan. But with the -- we were trying to step up our replacement activity, so right now we're projecting a nine-year replacement plan.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. And you mentioned that you're accelerating this program. But why nine years? Is that -- is there a limitation on how much you can replace in a year and that's what you're limiting it to, or are there other factors as to why you're not replacing more, for example?

MS. FLOYD: We are just -- we're trying to 1 consider the impact on customer rates, and we -- when we 2 3 originally requested approval of this program, we thought ten years would be reasonable just based on the 4 annual increase it would be to customers. 5 So with the -- what we're trying to do is 6 7 every year just spend a little bit more in order to lessen the impact that would, it would originally --8 9 that we expected it would originally take over ten years, but we're trying to keep in mind the customers' 10 rate impact long-term. 11 12 COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Thank you. That's all I had. 13 14 CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Okay. Thank you. Any further questions on Item Number 11? Okay. Thank you. 15 16 17 Now we're ready to entertain a motion on Items 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, and 12. 18 19 Okay.
