**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR FORMAL  
EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

Pursuant to Fla. R. Civ. P. 1.190(b) and Rule 28-106.24, Florida Administrative Code, Nicholas Randall Jones, Esq., on behalf of several interested Florida Power & Light Company (“FPL”) customers, hereby requests an extension of time to file a Petition for Formal Evidentiary Hearing following the Florida Public Service Commission’s (“FPSC”) approval of the Optional Non-Standard Meter Rider (“NSMR”), and in support thereof, states the following:

1. Counsel for Petitioners was initially retained on or about January 27, 2014 by a small number of FPL customers who wished to Petition FPSC for a formal evidentiary hearing following the approval of the Optional NSMR.
2. Since that date, and as of the date of this Motion, nearly 50 other FPL customers have asked to join as Petitioners, and that number continues to grow.
3. Furthermore, due to the expanse of time and documentation that undergirds FPSC’s decision, more time is requested to draft and submit a Petition that sufficiently addresses the material factual issues that Petitioners challenge.
4. Therefore, to accommodate those who wish to join this Petition and to draft a Petition of sufficient merit, Counsel for Petitioners requests an extension of the time by which to file a Petition in the amount of seven (7) days.
