

**FLORIDA CITY GAS  
PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS**

Florida City Gas submits this preliminary statement of issues and positions:

Issue 1:                What are the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

Florida City Gas:   An over-recovery of \$1,332,078.

Issue 2:                What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2014 through December 2014?

Florida City Gas:   An under-recovery of \$1,069,341.

Issue 3:                What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period January 2015 through December 2015?

Florida City Gas:   An over-recovery of \$262,737, for a true-up refund factor of 00.606 cents per therm.

Issue 4:                What are the levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2015 through December 2015?


Florida City Gas:   Based on the winter months of October through March the appropriate (cap) factors are 87.841 cents per therm before the regulatory assessment fees are added and 88.283 cents per therm with regulatory assessment fees included.

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Issue 5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

Florida City Gas: The factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2015 and should apply for bills rendered for meter readings taken between January 1, 2015 and December 31, 2015.


