CITIZENS' DIRECTIONS TO CLERK OF THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AND STATEMENT OF ACTS TO BE REVIEWED

Pursuant to Rule 9.200(a)(3), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, the Citizens of the State of Florida ("Citizens"), through the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), hereby direct the Clerk of the Florida Public Service Commission to include in the record described in Rule 9.220, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, the items identified herein.

Within these Directions, "OPC" or "Citizens" means the Office of Public Counsel; "FPL" refers to Florida Power & Light Company; "FIPUG" is the acronym for the Florida Industrial Power Users Group; and "FRF" means the Florida Retail Federation.

1. As stated in Citizens' Notice of Administrative Appeal, in the above case, Citizens' appeal Order No. PSC-14-0697-PCO-EI. Order No. PSC-14-0697-PCO-EI was the Order Denying the Office of Public Counsel's Motion to Dismiss Petition for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction and dealt solely with OPC's Motion to Dismiss FPL's June 25, 2014 Petition. Accordingly, unless otherwise specifically listed below, please exclude from the record on appeal all pleadings, orders, prefiled testimony, transcripts of hearings, exhibits, and all other documents in the docket file of Docket No. 140001-EI that relate to and are associated with the petitions filed by Duke Energy Florida, Tampa Electric Company, Gulf Power Company, and Florida Public Utilities Company. It is the intent of these Directions to exclude all documents that relate solely to utilities other than FPL, and to include documents that relate only to the subject matter jurisdiction issue regarding FPL's June 25, 2014 Petition.

In Order No. 14-0697-PCO-EI, the Commission denied OPC's Motion to Dimiss FPL's June 25, 2014 Petition for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction. OPC seeks review of this Commission order, which is limited to subject matter jurisdiction. Order No. PSC-14-0697-PCO-EI involves only the issue of whether the Commission is imbued with the subject matter jurisdiction to grant a prudence determination regarding investments in gas reserves and allow an investor-owned utility to recover those investments with a return through the Fuel Clause. Therefore, the documents contained in these Directions to the Clerk are only those documents from the record that relate to the subject matter jurisdiction issue.
