1. The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission served its First Set of Interrogatories on January 9, 2015, consisting of twenty-eight (28) Interrogatories.
2. Order No. PSC-14-0700-PCO-TP governs the procedural requirements in the instant proceeding, requiring that responses to discovery requests be served within twenty (20) days from the date of service.
