RE:	Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 150054-TL – Pet expedited review of growth code denials by the Number Pooling Administration Pensacola rate center by TCG South Florida, LLC (TCG)		

On January 7, 2015, TCG South Florida, LLC (TCG) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Pensacola exchange Orlando (ORLDFLMAGT0) switch. TCG requested 5 blocks to meet the request of a specific customer for 5,000 consecutive numbers in the format of 850-XXX-3,4,5,6, and 7. On January 7, 2015, TCG's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the utilization criteria.

On February 16, 2015, TCG filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Section 2.07C.5.e of the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM), staff has examined the TCG petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of Section 2.07C.5.e of the APM have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (March 13, 2015), as outlined in the APM expedited code denial process. NeuStar should be directed to provide TCG the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Pensacola exchange Orlando (ORLDFLMAGT0) switch.
