Draft must be presented at Issuer's address shown above on or before the Expiration Date.

This Letter of Credit sets forth in full the terms of Issuer's obligation to Beneficiary. This obligation cannot be modified by any reference in this Letter of Credit, or any document to which this Letter of Credit may be related.

This Letter of Credit expires on the Expiration Date.

DRAWINGS: Partial drawings shall not be permitted under this Letter of Credit.

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DOCUMENTS: The Draft must be accompanied by the following:

- The original Letter of Credit, together with any amendments;
- A sight draft drawn by Beneficiary on Issuer;
- A signed statement by Beneficiary including the following statement:

I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT I AM AN AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL OF THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSES OF DRAWING UNDER THIS LETTER OF CREDIT. I FURTHER CERTIFY THAT THE AMOUNT OF THE DRAFT IS PAYABLE PURSUANT TO THE COMMISSION'S FINAL ORDER, ISSUED IN DOCKET NO. 140239-WS, APPLICATION FOR A RATE INCREASE IN POLK COUNTY.

Issuer shall be entitled to accept a draft and the documentation described above, as required by the terms of this Letter of Credit, from any person purporting to be an authorized officer or representative of Beneficiary without any obligation or duty on the part of Issuer to verify the identity authority of the person presenting the Draft and such documentation.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: EXPIRATION DATE SHALL BE NINETY (90) DAYS FOLLOWING THE DATE OF FINAL FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION ORDER RELEASING INTERIM RATE GENERATED FUNDS TO ORCHID SPRINGS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OR REQUIRING A REFUND BY ORCHID SPRINGS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AND IN NO EVENT MORE THAN ONE YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THIS LETTER OF CREDIT.

EXPIRATION DATE: This Letter of Credit expires at the close of business at Issuer's address at 4:00 PM on March 5, 2016. Issuer agrees to honor all Drafts presented in strict compliance with the provisions of this Letter of Credit on or before the Expiration Date.

TRANSFERABILITY: This Letter of Credit is non-transferable.

APPLICABLE LAW: This Letter of Credit shall be governed by the Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits, 2007 Revision, International Chamber of Commerce Publication No. 600 (UCP), or any later version or amendment.

This Letter of Credit shall also be governed by the laws of Florida, the United States of America, so long as such laws are not inconsistent with the UCP.
