Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) requests confidential classification of FPL's Responses to the Office of Public Counsel's First Request For Production of Documents, items 6, 8, 12, and 13, filed on March 23, 2015. The responses for items 6, 8, 12, and 13 are confidential in their entirety.

FPL's request for confidential classification of this data was filed on March 23, 2015, and is FPSC Document No. 01605-15. That filing inadvertently omitted the Exhibit B cover page which identified the confidential documents responsive to OPC's Request No. 13. FPL filed the omitted page on March 26, 2015, requesting that it be inserted to the Exhibit B filed on March 23, 2015. (See FPSC Document No. 01685-15)

Staff has reviewed Florida Power & Light Company's confidentiality request, and in staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in FPSC Document No. 01606-15 be approved.
