# DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, INC. AND THE CITY OF LEESBURG'S RESPONSE TO STAFF'S FIRST DATA REQUEST (NOS. 1 - 8) Docket No. 150077-EI

1. Please provide a copy of an official Florida Department of Transportation General Highway County map for each affected county depicting boundary lines established by the territorial agreement, as required by Rule 25-6.0440(1)(f), Florida Administrative Code.

#### **RESPONSE**

Official Florida Department of Transportation maps with the territorial boundaries affected for the proposed Agreement in Lake and Sumter counties are attached as Attachment 1.

2. Please list any differences between the prior agreement which expired on July 22, 2013, and the proposed agreement.

#### **RESPONSE**

The territorial boundaries in the proposed Agreement have been modified in comparison to those as set forth in the prior Leesburg and DEF territorial agreement approved by the Commission on July 22, 1983, by Order No. 12289 in Docket No. 820492-EU.

The proposed Agreement has been negotiated for a term of 30 years and after the expiration of that term, the Agreement shall remain in effect until and unless either Party provides written notice of termination. The prior Agreement had a duration of 30 years.

The territorial boundary maps in the proposed agreement have been updated to a GIS format and demonstrate the territorial boundary lines in much greater detail. A written description is included in the proposed agreement as required pursuant to Rule 25-6.0440(1)(a), F.A.C.

3. Are the territorial boundary lines in the proposed agreement the same as in the prior agreement which expired on July 22, 2013? If not, please provide a map showing the areas transferred.

#### RESPONSE

The territorial boundaries in the proposed Agreement have been modified. The maps submitted with the proposed Agreement represent the modified boundaries and are attached herein as Attachment 3.

- 4. Please refer to Attachment A of the petition, page 5 of 68, Sections 0.1 and 0.3:
  - a. Please explain why there is a lapse in time between the July 22, 2013 expiration date of the prior agreement and the February 9, 2015 date shown in Section 0.1.

#### RESPONSE

DEF and the City of Leesburg needed to perform due diligence to evaluate the Prior Agreement and determine any conflicts, known or unknown, which necessitated resolution as a part of the new Agreement. Part of this due diligence included validating the proposed territorial boundaries as depicted in the Joint Petition between DEF and the City of Leesburg. After the expiration of the Prior Agreement, the Parties continued to abide by its term while the new Agreement was being negotiated.

b. Are the parties abiding by the terms of the prior agreement for the period of time between its expiration and Commission approval of the new agreement? If not, please explain.

#### **RESPONSE**

Yes, the Parties have been abiding to the terms of the prior agreement and have worked together collaboratively to construct the proposed Agreement.

5. Please explain why certain customers (i.e., extra-territorial) are located within the service territory of the other party, i.e., Leesburg.

#### RESPONSE

Due to the location of the Extra-Territorial customers that are subject to transfer to DEF, and based on sound economic considerations and good engineering practices, it was not operationally and economically feasible for DEF to serve these customers previously. However, DEF and Leesburg have concluded that DEF will now serve these customers should the proposed Agreement be approved.

6. Will any facilities be transferred in conjunction with the transfer of customers, and if so, what is the purchase price?

#### **RESPONSE**

As set forth in <u>Section 3.4 Compensation for Transferred Facilities</u>, DEF may elect to purchase the electric facilities used exclusively for providing electric service to the Extra-Territorial customers using a common engineering cost estimation methodology such as the Handy Whitman Index. The Parties have tentatively agreed to exchange and purchase the required facilities. The Parties have not yet valued the facilities but plan to as soon as practical should the proposed Agreement be approved.

7. Please provide a map that displays the extra-territorial customers before and after the transfer.

#### RESPONSE

The territorial boundary maps as set forth in the prior Leesburg and DEF territorial agreement approved by the Commission on July 22, 1983, by Order No. 12289 in Docket No. 820492-EU 2 display the Extra-Territorial customers before any transfer would occur should the proposed Agreement be approved are attached as Attachment 2. The territorial boundary lines that would display the Extra-Territorial customers after any transfer would occur should the proposed Agreement be approved is attached as Attachment 3.




#### **RESPONSE**

agreement








Territorial maps that display the Extra-Territorial customers before the transfer




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




SOUTHEAST QUAD TWN - 18S RNG - 24E LAKE COUNTY, FL
