Item 12 involves staff's recommendation to suspend the revised net metering tariff and agreement adopting terms of the standard interconnection agreement for Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 renewable generator systems. Staff requests approval to make an oral modification to Staff Analysis for Issue 1, page 3. The requested modification accurately reflects the purpose of the petition filed in Docket No. 150099-EI, which is for approval of a tariff revision that does not involve a rate increase. The requested modification does not change the substance of the recommendation. The change is highlighted in yellow, below:

Issue 1, Page 3, Requested Change:

<u>Issue 1</u>: Should TECO's petition for the approval of its revised net metering tariff and agreement adopting terms of the SIA for Tier 1, Tier 2, or Tier 3 renewable generator systems be suspended pending a final decision in this docket?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. The revised net metering tariff and agreement adopting terms of the SIA for Tier 1, Tier 2, or Tier 3 renewable generator systems should be suspended pending final decision in this docket. (Ames, B. Crawford)

Staff Analysis: TECO filed its petition on March 27, 2015 seeking approval of its revised net metering tariff and agreement adopting terms of the SIA for Tier 1, Tier 2, or Tier 3 renewable generator systems

The suspension of the <u>proposed tariff revision</u> rate increase is authorized by Section 366.06(3), F.S., which provides:

Pending a final order by the commission in any rate proceeding under this section, the commission may withhold consent to the operation of all or any portion of the new rate schedules, delivering to the utility requesting such increase, within 60 days, a reason or written statement of good cause for withholding its consent.
