Why Backyard Mains?

- FCG has over 1,200 miles of mains in rear easements
- > 254 miles have been identified as at risk or having accessibility issues
- ▶ 88% are located in Miami and 12% in Brevard
- safety and has resulted in compliance issues, Inability to access this pipe poses a threat to increased theft of service, and difficulties shutting off customers for non payment.








