## SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF TW TELECOM

tw telecom of florida l.p., tw telecom of louisiana llc, tw telecom of mississippi llc, tw telecom of tennessee llc and tw telecom of texas llc (collectively, "Applicant" or "tw telecom"), which are subsidiaries of Level 3 Communications, LLC, seek authorization pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214(a), and Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue its provision of Complete Dynamic ATM services in the El Paso and Houston, Texas, Jacksonville and Tampa, Florida, Lake Charles, Louisiana, and Memphis, Tennessee and Mississippi metropolitan areas.

Applicant provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules:

 <u>Name and Address of the Carrier</u>: tw telecom, 1025 Eldorado Boulevard, Broomfield, Colorado 80021.

2. <u>Date of Planned Service Discontinuance</u>: Applicant plans to discontinue the affected services on or around November 4, 2015, or as soon thereafter as any necessary regulatory approvals are obtained.

3. <u>Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected</u>: Applicant proposes to discontinue the affected service in the El Paso and Houston, Texas, Jacksonville and Tampa, Florida, Lake Charles, Louisiana, and Memphis, Tennessee and Mississippi metropolitan areas.

4. <u>Description of Services Affected</u>: The Complete Dynamic ATM service is a flexible bandwidth bundled service consisting of local exchange service with selected features, a Long Distance and/or Toll Free usage allowance of 2,500 minutes, shared web hosting, and Internet access.

# 5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected

<u>Customers</u>: Applicant sent a written notification of the planned discontinuance to customers utilizing the services in accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules. Customer notifications were sent by first-class U.S. Mail on September 14, 2015. A copy of the notification is attached to this application.

6. <u>Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-dominant with</u> <u>Respect to the Service to be Discontinued</u>: Applicant is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

7. <u>Other information</u>: In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules, a copy of this application is being mailed concurrently with its filing to the

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entities listed on the attached certificate of service. Please direct questions regarding this application to the undersigned.

<u>Conclusion</u>: The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of Applicant's Complete Dynamic ATM services. Advance notice has been provided to all affected customers, giving them ample time to arrange substitute services, which are readily available and include, but are not limited to, other services offered by Level 3 Communications. Therefore, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Section 63.71 application.
