Was that --13 MS. HELTON: Mary Anne Helton. I'm here as an 14 advisor for you in all of the dockets. MR. BECK: And Charlie Beck, General Counsel. 15 16 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Is that all the appearances? 17 Okay. So the order of the dockets today are 18 going to be the 03 docket, then the 04 docket, then the 19 02 docket, then the 07 docket, and then the 01 docket. 20 Preliminary matters, staff. 21 MS. MAPP: Yes, Mr. Chairman. Staff will note 22 for the record that St. Joe Natural Gas Company has been 23 excused from the prehearing and hearing, and Peoples has 24 been excused from the prehearing in the 03 and the

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04 dockets.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay.

MS. MAPP: There are also proposed stipulations on all issues as reflected in Sections VIII and X of the Prehearing Order.

We'll start with Section I of the 03 docket.

I see nobody, so Section II. Section III. Don't be
shy. Section IV. Section V. Section VI.

MS. MAPP: Mr. Chairman?

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Yes.

MS. MAPP: Staff would like to point out that witnesses may be excused if no Commissioner seeks cross-examination. At this time it appears that all witnesses can be excused, but staff will confirm this with each Commissioner and contact the parties prior to the hearing.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Anything else in the VI section? How about the VII section? Let's move on to Section No. VIII. Staff?

MS. MAPP: Yes. Staff -- we would like to

comment, as stated earlier, that there are proposed stipulations on all issues, with OPC taking no position at this time. Staff would also suggest that the parties who have not yet taken a position or wish to change their position be allowed to submit their position in writing no later than noon tomorrow, October 20th. If a party fails to take a position by that time, the Prehearing Order will reflect no position for that party on that issue.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Let's go ahead and make that the end of the day tomorrow rather than noon. We'll stay consistent.

Any questions on what staff just said about Section VIII?

MR. REHWINKEL: Mr. Chairman -- CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Yes, sir.

MR. REHWINKEL: -- the Public Counsel will provide verbiage to the Commission and staff that will indicate that we take no position on all of the issues, but it will be language similar to what I submitted in the 07 docket that has a little bit of explanation. But the bottom line is that we take no position, and thus we do not stand in the way of any stipulation that the parties and the company -- the company and staff might enter into.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. 1 MR. REHWINKEL: But we will provide that 2 3 language in Word format to the staff and parties. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Anybody else on --4 we're still on Section VIII. 5 Okay. Section IX, exhibit list. 6 7 MS. MAPP: Staff has prepared a Comprehensive Exhibit List which will be distributed to the parties 8 9 prior to the hearing, which will include all prefiled exhibits and testimony. And if the parties have any 10 objections, they will be corrected within that list at 11 12 that time. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Anything else in Section IX? 13 14 Section X. MS. MAPP: I'll note again that there are 15 proposed stipulations on all issues, and the Prehearing 16 17 Order will be changed to reflect that, along with Office of Public Counsel's position on those stipulations as 18 19 well. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Section XI. There are no 20 21 pending motions in this docket? 22 MS. MAPP: No. 23 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Section XII.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Nothing else for Section XIII. How about Section XIV, rulings? Opening statements, if you choose to use them, will be about five minutes. It will be five minutes, not about. It can be shorter, just don't go longer. And if you choose to waive the opening statements, that's fine. Briefs will be 20 pages. Any questions or concerns about that?

Okay. Staff, did you have something else for Section XIV?

MS. MAPP: No, Mr. Chairman. That's all. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Other matters. Are there any other matters to come before us during this prehearing for this section -- I'm sorry, for this docket, Docket No. 3? MS. MAPP: Nothing from staff. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. We will adjourn for Docket No. 3. (Prehearing Conference concluded at 2:14 p.m.)
