In Item 2 staff is recommending that the Commission propose the amendment of Rules 25-6.093, 25-6.097, 25-6.100, 25-7.079, 25-7.083, and 25-7.085, Florida Administrative Code. The rules implement recent amendments to Section 366.05, Florida Statutes, which impose new requirements on electric and gas utilities regarding customer billing, customer deposits, and customer information.

Section 366.95, Florida Statutes, requires billing notices to customers for electric utilities that have obtained a financing order for nuclear assets and have caused nuclear asset-recovery bonds to be issued. The rules have been clarified and updated, and obsolete or redundant language has been removed. Staff is available for any questions.
