QUESTION:

Please provide, absent the agreement included as Exhibit B, the amount that would have been calculated for the Capacity Account for each month of September 2015 through December 2015.

RESPONSE:

The Capacity Account balance was zero, and would have been zero throughout the time period of the response.

Originally, the contract amount was for 7 MW. This was increased to 8.5 MW in 1995, and then to 11 MW in 1997. The capacity payment rates were not increased. The Early Payment Offset amounts were thus calculated on an 11 MW capacity. The amounts in the Capacity Account during the early payment period prior to 1997 averaged 7.75 MW of capacity. This difference allowed the balance in the Capacity Account to be reduced to zero by 2003, at which point the calculation of the Capacity Account balance was discontinued. Since 2003, the Capacity Account balance has been zero through the agreement termination date of November 3rd, 2015.
