### SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, LLC

AT&T Services, Inc., on behalf of its affiliate, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Alabama, AT&T Florida, AT&T Georgia, AT&T Kentucky, AT&T Louisiana, AT&T Mississippi, AT&T North Carolina, AT&T South Carolina, and AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T"), applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended ("the Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.71, to discontinue BellSouth AccuPulse service throughout its service territory in Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.

As required by Section 63.71(a) and (b) of the Commission's rules, AT&T provides the following information:

Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(2), (b)(2)):

AT&T plans to discontinue offering this service to new customers on or after April 29,

2016, pending regulatory approval. In addition, effective April 29, 2016, AT&T will no longer

renew existing service agreements and will no longer accept new move, add or change orders from

existing customers. AT&T currently plans to discontinue service to existing customers upon

expiration of their existing term agreements or July 30, 2017, whichever is later.

Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

AT&T will no longer offer this service in Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana,

Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.

Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

AT&T's AccuPulse service is a digital, switched service that provides full duplex, 56 kbps

information transport via a specially equipped AccuPulse access line, and allows a maximum of

56 kbps calls. The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the discontinuance

of this service because there is very little demand for this service as the market has transitioned to

faster and more efficient technologies.

Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R.

§63.71(b)(3)):

AT&T sent written notice to its customers on January 22, 2016 via First Class U.S Mail.<sup>1</sup>



Important Notice Regarding AccuPulse Service\*
Service Discontinuance and Changes in service Effective April 29, 2016
Service Withdrawal Effective July 30, 2017

Thank you for using AT&T for your business service needs. We want to make you aware of planned changes to your AccuPulse Service, which will require coordination and action by you in the near future. Because of decreasing demand for the service triggered by the market evolving to IP-based network services, AT&T has decided to discontinue provision of the AccuPulse Service, as set forth below.

Effective April 29, 2016, (and pending regulatory approval where such approval is required)

AccuPulse Service will no longer be available to new customers in the states of AL, FL, GA, KY, LA, MS, NC, SC, TN.

Current AT&T customers with AccuPulse Service may retain existing service arrangements subject to the following changes, unless specified to the contrary in existing service agreements:

- Effective April 29, 2016, AT&T will no longer renew service agreements for AccuPulse Service. Following the expiration of your current AccuPulse Service term agreement, AT&T will provide AccuPulse on a month-to-month basis until the service is disconnected. During any month-to-month service period, AT&T may change the rates, terms and conditions of the service upon 30 day notification.
- Effective April 29, 2016, Move, Addition and Change orders for AccuPulse Service
  will no longer be accepted. After April 29, 2016 new requests for physical changes to your
  service including the upgrade or downgrade of access/port speed, installation of new service,
  or moves to different service address will not be provisioned.
- Effective July 30, 2017, (or upon expiration of your current AccuPulse Service term agreement, whichever is later), AccuPulse Service will be withdrawn from operation, and existing customers' service will be scheduled for disconnection.
