This firm represents Sunny Shores Water Company, Inc. ("Sunny Shores"). I am in receipt of your letter dated February 15, 2016 regarding certain deficiencies in the Application submitted to your office on January 15, 2016 on behalf of Sunny Shores. In response to your letter, I provide the following:

- 1. Sunny Shores' Federal Employment Identification Number is <u>59-2665373</u>.
- 2. Sunny Shores is an active corporation which has been registered to do business with the Florida Department of State since February 3, 1986, under <u>Document Number H97120</u>. Enclosed please find the Florida Department of State's Division of Corporation's records for Sunny Shores, which shows its business name and registration/document number. Sunny Shores does not operate under a fictitious name.
- 3. Sunny Shores' Application is not submitted because of the proposed sale of the utility. As set forth in its Application at Exhibit "A," Sunny Shores has been owned from its inception by Jack E. Mason. Jack E. Mason transferred ownership of the company to his son, Jack E. Mason II, who has owned and operated the company since 2008. Subsequent to said transfer, Jack E. Mason II, transferred ownership of the company into joint names with his wife, Debbie A. Mason. These transactions were handled as gifts between family members, and therefore, there is no purchase agreement, financing or other commercial transaction related to the transactions, and no documentation evidencing the transfers.
- 4. When Jack E. Mason, II acquired Sunny Shores is 2008, he acquired Sunny Shores in its entirety, including all assets and liabilities. The proposed transfer outlined in the Application is similarly a proposed transfer of the entire entity, including all assets and liabilities.

- 5. The proposed transfer of Sunny Shores' majority organizational control from Jack E. Mason, II to Jack E. Mason, II and Debbie A. Mason is handled as a gift between spouses, for no consideration.
- 6. Notwithstanding the transfer of organizational control, all of Sunny Shores' assets (including any and all customer deposits and interest thereon, guaranteed revenue contracts, developer agreements, customer advances, debt of the utility, and leases, where applicable) shall remain the property of Sunny Shores.
- 7. Sunny Shores' books and records are and will continue to be maintained using the 1996 National Association of Regulatory Utilities Commissioners (NARUC) Uniform System of Accounts (USOA).
- 8. Sunny Shores' books and records have been and will continue to be maintained at its principal address, 3827 116th Street West, Bradenton, Florida 34210.
- 9. Sunny Shores' Annual Report for 2014 was filed with the PSC on March 16, 2015. A copy is enclosed for your reference. As stated therein, Sunny Shores Annual Report shows all assets and liabilities of every kind and character, and has been prepared in accordance with Rule 25-30.115 and NARUC's USOA. Sunny Shores' Annual Report for 2015 is not yet completed, but once it has been prepared, a copy will be filed with the PSC as required.
- 10. Sunny Shores has no funding agreements with any person or entity. Sunny Shores' operating expenses are funded by the fees it collects from its customers. As such, no funding statements are being provided in connection with the Application.
- 11. Sunny Shores has no outstanding regulatory assessment fees, fines or refunds. Sunny Shores' Annual Report for 2014 was filed with the PSC on March 16, 2015. Again, a copy is enclosed for your reference.
- 12. All of Sunny Shores' Tariff sheets were provided with Sunny Shores' Application. There will be no changes to the tariff sheets as a result of the transfer sought in the Application. A copy of the current tariff sheet is enclosed here for your convenience.
