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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 7. Good morning.

MR. LEE: Good morning. Commissioners, I'm Daniel Lee from engineering staff.

Item 7 addresses the petition by Duke Energy regarding its proposed tariffs for the Hines Chillers Uprate Project. The project was approved by the Commission in 2014 in a need determination proceeding. The updated cost is about \$9 million lower than the estimated cost considered in that proceeding. Recovery of such project costs is allowed under the settlement agreement approved by the Commission in 2013.

Staff recommends approval of the proposed tariff related to the Phase 1 revenue requirements. Staff notes the Phase 2 revenue requirement and the rates will be addressed in a separate docket. No customers or entities other than the petitioners filed comments in this docket. I think staff is prepared to answer questions.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you very much.

Commissioners, any questions?

COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Move staff.

COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Second.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Are there any further

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discussion?

I do have a question. If there is a deferential that would occur, how it will be addressed. Would it be addressed in Phase 2 or in the next base rate case proceeding?

MS. LEE: I think the recommendation on page 3 stated that there's no such true-up mechanisms in a similar manner to cost recovery under the paragraph 16A of the settlement agreement. I don't know whether the company's representative here is able to address that.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. I think Mr. Ellis could provide some additional detail.

MR. ELLIS: Phillip Ellis with Commission staff. Chairman, with regards to Phase 1, we will have an opportunity during the second docket, which will address Phase 2 costs, to review any potential true-up of the Phase 1 portion. However, for the Phase 2 portion, there will not be an opportunity for true-up until the company's next rate case, to my understanding.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: When are we going to expect to see Phase 2 come before the Commission?

MR. ELLIS: Phase 2 was filed last week.

Staff has not yet filed the CASR for that item. I don't yet know the schedule on that. My apologies.
