I am on a fixed income. My disability check covers our house hold expences. water, electric, food, insurances, car payment, my medican, Dr visits, and a few other expences. My husband is selfemployed and his income covers our house payment, and his truck payment, and a few other items. My husband and i live a very simple life with an average home. We do not qualify for any Government assistance. So I budget everything that comes out of my money to pay our monthly bills which does not leave much for extras. the little cost of living that I get from Social Security is not much, and in some cases I don't even see a cost of living

increase. So every month I write what we can spend on utilities and we have to stay in that budget. It is not easy to find ways to cut things so you can stay in budget. We use our fireplace in the winter months so we don't go over budget on our electric bill. And in the summer months we try to hold off on using the A/C until it gets so hot that we can't stand it. We set our thermostat on 78 or higher to stay within budget. I don't know how Gulf Power thinks that we as Americans can keep paying these high price hikes and live comfortable.
