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PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Good evening, everyone. How are you? Everyone is doing well. Small crowd tonight, but I will assure you we've had big -- big, big crowds to compensate for the amount of folks today here in the audience.

Today is February 1st. The time is 6:00.

This is the customer service hearing in the

Utilities, Inc. of Florida rate case. And I want to
thank you all and welcome you for being here today.

My name is Julie Brown. I'm Chairman of the Public Service Commission. With me today are Commissioners as well, and I'd like to give them an opportunity to introduce themselves to you, starting to my right.

COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Hello. My name is Art Graham, and I'm glad for the handful of you that have shown up, took the time to come for this hearing today.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Good evening. I'm Ronald Brisé. And as my colleagues have stated, I'm happy to be here as well and excited to hear from you, as this is your hearing.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. And I appreciate my colleague mentioning that. These customer service hearings are designated to hear directly from you. They

are -- it is your opportunity to speak to us about the 1 2 proposed rate increase. Staff, could you please read the notice. 3 MR. TRIERWEILER: By notice issued on 4 December 14th, 2016, this time and place has been set 5 for a customer service hearing in Docket 160101-WS. 6 7 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. MR. TRIERWEILER: The details are more clearly 8 9 laid out in the notice. CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. At this time, 10 we'll take appearances of counsel, starting with the 11 Petitioner, Utilities, Inc. of Florida. 12 MR. FRIEDMAN: Martin Friedman on behalf of 13 Utilities, Inc. of Florida. 14 15 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. MR. KELLY: J.R. Kelly with the Office of 16 17 Public Counsel. We represent the ratepayers in this 18 matter. 19 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. Notice of 20 appearance. 21 MS. HELTON: Mary Anne Helton and Walt 22 Trierweiler of the Commission staff. 23 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. Again, I want to 24 take this opportunity to thank those that have shown up 25 here today to come out. This -- these customer service

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hearings are an integral part of our overall rate case process. We have eight scheduled throughout the state. We've already conducted — this will be our sixth customer service hearing. We have two more. And then later in May we will have a technical hearing where we take the evidence and substance of the case, and that will go for about a week. But this is your customer opportunity to tell us how you feel about the proposed rate increase, your quality of service, any issues you may have, billing, et cetera, and so we appreciate taking that into consideration.

I'd like to note that there are customer service representatives here from Utilities, Inc. of Florida to address any billing issues. We also have Public Service Commission staff here as well, and for the record purposes, I'd like to just lay out who is here with us today from the Public Service Commission staff. We've got Andrew Maurey; Chris Church; Mimi Hearn; Conrad Howard; Patti Daniel; Phillip Ellis; Mary Anne Helton, as you heard; Walt Trierweiler; Cindy Muir; Kelly Thompson; Rachel Arnold; Linda Boles; and Carlotta Stauffer, our Clerk.

This is an official hearing. As such, customers who would like to speak need to be sworn

in prior to that. It is being transcribed and will 1 become part of the official record in this rate case 2 3 proceeding. And with that, you may have noticed some of the speaker sign-up sheets. I'm not sure if 4 5 anybody here in the audience has signed up or not. Mr. Kelly would probably be -- no? Seeing that, I 6 7 don't have to go into that. But whether you'd like to leave comments with us today, you could submit 8 9 them in writing. We have sheets that are disseminated at the front from our PIO officer, 10 Cindy Muir. You could leave them today, you could 11 12 write, and we will absolutely take written or oral comments into consideration. Feel free to take some 13 14 home to neighbors. Whether your comments are made 15 written or verbally, we -- they are part of the overall process and the Commission will take those 16 17 into consideration. So we appreciate that. 18 And at this time, the parties could give 19 opening statements, if they like, or they could 2.0 waive them. And I --21

MR. FRIEDMAN: Utilities, Inc. will waive their opening statement. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.

MR. KELLY: Yes.

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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you so much.

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Now moving into public comment, seeing that there are no customers here -- are there -- one more chance here. Are there any public -- any customers here who would like to give public testimony? Otherwise, I will waive the details into the process.

Seeing none, appreciate you coming out here today. If there are no public customers here who would like to -- or customers who would like to testify, then that -- this would conclude the proceeding. Going once, going twice.

Seeing none, Commissioners, if you have any closing comments.

Seeing none -- Mr. Kelly.

MR. KELLY: Madam Chair, I was going to say if -- there's a few customers here. If they have any questions once you conclude, if you guys -- I represent you, and if you'd like to come up and ask me any questions about the process, I'll hang around a little bit and try to answer any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Kelly, for that. And the same goes as well for Public Service Commission staff, and I'll just volunteer Utilities, Inc. of Florida as well.

So with that, appreciate you taking the

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time to come out. Public input is -- I'm seeing a customer come in and I don't want to conclude the proceeding until we know yet if he would like to testify.

> Sir, would you like to testify before us? (Indicating no.)

Okay. Thank you. Again, please feel free to submit written comments because the docket is quite full and we are reviewing them. And, again, appreciate the time coming out here. And with that, we'll have two more service hearings until we begin the technical hearing, and thank you for coming out. And this concludes the service hearing.
