To whom it may concern regarding electronic filing in the Second District Court of Appeal:

Please find enclosed this court's new administrative order 2017-1 regarding routine transmissions to this court by clerks of lower tribunals including state agency clerks. Commencing March 1, 2017, notices of appeal and other filings must be delivered to this court electronically through eDCA, as occurs at the other district courts of appeal.

To file, you will need to register with eDCA; a link is available on our website, www.2dca.org. As explained in the administrative order, each agency clerk should register only one account for filing. This can be undertaken now, or you may wait until you have a need to file. While eDCA will be used for sending notices of appeal and routine submissions to this court, records must still be transmitted to the court through our FTP server.

Based on the experience of the other DCAs, a smooth transition to the new system is anticipated. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2017-1 Electronic Transmission of Case Initiation Documents and Filings Other Than Records on Appeal by Lower Tribunal Clerks

Pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.040(g), lower tribunal clerks are required to transmit a certified copy of the notice of appeal to this court.

Effective March 1, 2017, notices of appeal, accompanying documents, and routine transmissions to this court shall be filed through this court's secure eDCA portal.

All lower court, lower tribunal, and state agency clerks who will be transmitting documents to this court must register with eDCA prior to electronic filing. Registration is now available on this court's website, <u>www.2dca.org</u>. Each clerk's office should complete only one registration, and all transmissions through eDCA must be submitted using the clerk's registration.

Electronic notices of appeal shall contain either a scanned or electronic certification and shall reflect the date of the filing with the submitting entity.

The clerk of this court is authorized to direct lower tribunal clerks how these documents are to be transmitted. In so doing, this court's clerk may require certain types of documents to be bundled as a single .pdf document while other types be submitted on their own as a single document.

Filing fees owed to this court but delivered to the lower tribunal clerk shall be sent separately by mail to this court.

Notices of appeal of orders summarily denying motions for postconviction relief are to be accompanied by the summary record pursuant to rule 9.141(b)(2)(A). Summary records shall be transmitted electronically through the court's FTP server. In no event may a summary record be transmitted through the portal.

A Notice of Appeal Transmittal Form, substantially mirroring the attached form, shall be completed and transmitted with the notice of appeal. This court's clerk may modify the transmittal form to serve the objectives of this order.

Clerk-to-clerk transmissions through the portal are not confined to case initiation documents accompanying a notice of appeal. Routine transmissions by lower tribunal clerks to this court following the initiation of an appeal shall be undertaken electronically through the eDCA portal.
