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Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Gulf Power Company (Gulf) requests confidential classification of certain documents and information produced by the Office of Public Council (OPC) in response to Gulf's First Request for Production of Documents (No. 1).

The information contains allocation factors for affiliate transactions. These factors could be used by Gulf's competitors to gain confidential details regarding internal cost allocation methodologies. Staff has reviewed OPC's response to Gulf's First Request for Production of Documents (No. 1) and believes the information meets the criteria for confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e) F.S.
