- 3. Pursuant to the requirements in this docket, FPUC, concurrently with the filing of this petition, files the testimony of Ms. Michelle Napier, along with Schedule A-7 (Exhibit MDN-1) for its consolidated gas division for the period January 2016 through December 2016.
- 4. As indicated in the testimony of Ms. Napier, FPUC's final true-up amount for the period January 2016 through December 2016, including interest, net of estimated true-up for the same period, is an over-recovery of \$3,403. This reflects the difference between the

Company's actual over-recovery of \$1,645,762, for the period as compared to its estimated over-recovery of \$1,642,359 for the same period, which was based on six months of actual and six months of estimated data.
