By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC or Utility) provide responses to the following data requests.

Please assume a renewable generator with a 10 MW output providing firm capacity with an inservice date of January 1, 2018, operating at the minimum capacity factor required for full capacity payments and a contract duration of 20 years. Please state the capacity factor assumed for the calculations. Please calculate the total Net Present Value (NPV) of all payments in 2018 dollars, and also provide an explanation of the method and rate used to calculate the NPV.

Please provide the completed table for each of the following four scenarios:

- Inside Northeast Florida Division
- Delivering to interconnection for Northeast Florida Division
- Inside Northwest Florida Division
- Delivering to interconnection for Northwest Florida Division
