CHAIRMAN BROWN: Good morning, everyone, and thank you for being here today on this lovely rainy day in Tallahassee. Today is May 4th, 2017, and this is the Special Agenda in the Gulf rate case, Docket No. 160186-EI along with 160170-EI. And, staff, if you could kick it off for us with an intro, please.

MS. DRAPER: Good morning, Commissioners. Elisabeth Draper with staff. The Commission is here today to vote upon the rates and tariffs for Gulf Power Company that will go into effect July 1, 2017. The rates presented in the staff recommendation are the result of a settlement agreement entered into between the company, the Office of Public Counsel, the Florida Industrial Power Users Group, and the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy in Gulf's rate case that was initiated in August of last year.

The Commission approved the settlement on April 4th and, pursuant to the settlement, Gulf filed rates and tariffs implementing the settlement on April 18th. Customers will be notified of the new rates and charges with their July bills. A residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month will see a \$2 -- a \$6.20 increase, or approximately 5 percent. Commercial customers will see bill increases between

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3 and 6 percent, depending on usage.

Staff has an oral modification to the recommendation on page 3 of 3 of Attachment A. The current and proposed base charges for the standby rate schedule should be \$261.68 instead of \$261.88 as shown in the recommendation. The corrected page has been placed in the docket file and emailed to all the Commissioners. That concludes staff's introduction.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Ms. Draper. And as we all know, a lot of work went into this, into the decision that we ultimately made last month. This seems to be more of a ministerial function for us, implementing the rates and tariffs today.

So, Commissioners, are there any questions or any discussion points? If not, we're ripe for a motion.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Move staff.

COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Second.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: With the oral modification, I assume?
