Dear Mr. Mills:

The Commission has received your letter requesting that the utility's base facility charge (BFC) be increased by \$1 to reflect the increase in billing service per customer by Automated Billing Services (ABS). Currently, the utility's BFC includes \$2.50 for billing services provided by ABS, which was approved by Order No. PSC-10-0367-PAA-WU, in Docket No. 100011-WU. Additionally, the utility verbally requested the Commission to revaluate its current miscellaneous service charges.

As discussed in our previous phone conversations, in order for the Commission to evaluate a possible increase to a monthly recurring rate, Wildwood would need to file this request as a limited proceeding or staff-assisted rate case and pay the appropriate filing fee. However, Wildwood's miscellaneous service charges can be evaluated through a tariff proceeding, once cost justification has been provided by the utility, which does not require a filing fee. Please respond to this letter no later than June 7, 2017, indicating how the utility would like to proceed.
