Docket No. 170001-EI – Fuel and purchased power cost recovery clause with generating performance incentive factor.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve DEF's Petition for a mid-course correction to its 2017 fuel cost recovery factors and the associated tariff sheets?

Recommendation: Yes. Staff recommends that the Commission approve DEF's Petition for mid-course correction to its 2017 fuel cost recovery factors and the associated tariff sheets. The revised fuel cost recovery factors and associated tariff sheets should become effective with the July 2017 billing cycle and continue until the generation base rate adjustment (GBRA) for the Citrus Unit 1 Combined Cycle facility (Citrus 1) is placed into rates.
