Amendment to Reflect Fictitious Name Adoption

Dear Ms. Stauffer:

Network Billing Systems LLC dba Fusion dba Solex ("NBS") hereby requests that its local exchange and interexchange operating authorities reflect the Company's dual assumed names of "Fusion" and "Solex." In support of its request NBS states as follows.

On June 6, 2017, NBS submitted a notice of Network Billing Systems L.L.C. acquisition of certain assets of BCN Telecom, Inc. ("Notice"). The Notice indicated that acquired subscriber accounts would be served under the assumed name "Solex." NBS also made reference to use of the assumed "Fusion" name when serving existing Florida subscribers. On June 12, 2017, Greg Fogleman, Public Utility Supervisor advised that NBS current operating authority did not reflect either assumed name. In light of the foregoing, NBS requests that the Company's interexchange authority, Company Code TJ158, and competitive local exchange authority, Company Code TY047, be amended to reflect the "Fusion" and "Solex" assumed names respectively. Mr. Fogleman has confirmed that both assumed names have been registered with the Florida Secretary of State.
