2 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Items 4, 6, 7,
3 and 8, can we please take those up in -- in group?

4 Good morning.

5 MS. THOMPSON: Good morning, Commissioners.
6 Takira Thompson with Commission staff. Item
7 Nos. 4, 6, 7, and 8 are petitions for approval of
8 the revised standard offer contracts and associated
9 schedules for each of Florida's investor-owned
10 electric utilities, excluding Duke electric -- Duke
11 Energy Florida.

12 Florida Statutes require that each investor-
13 owned utility continuously offers to purchase
14 capacity and energy from renewable energy
15 generators and small qualifying facilities.

16 Commission rules implement the statute by
17 requiring each investor-owned utility to provide a
18 standard offer contract based on the next avoidable
19 fossil-fuel generating unit identified in
20 utilities' ten-year site plan by April 1st of each
21 year. Staff has reviewed each utility's revised
22 standard offer contracts and associated schedules
23 and recommends that each is approved as filed.

24 No comments were filed in these dockets. And
25 staff is available for any questions. And the

1 utilities are here as well.

2 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Ms. Thompson. And
3 these items are very typical in the work that we
4 do. They're not substantive changes.
