

RATE SCHEDULE OL-1 OUTDOOR LIGHTING

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all members for year-round outdoor lighting of yards, driveways, walkways, highways, roads and other areas by high pressure sodium lamps. Lights should be at locations which are easily and economically accessible to Cooperative equipment and personnel for construction and maintenance.

All outdoor lights should be installed on existing facilities (where possible) or short extensions thereto, in areas where a lighting system is either not provided or is not sufficient to cover the lighting needs of a particular consumer or location.

Where existing Cooperative-owned poles are deemed inadequate or unsuitable by either of the parties to this agreement, the Member agrees to furnish an easement for any additional poles required and necessary right of way. The Member agrees to permit any tree trimming required for service conductors and lighting units or units. The Member agrees that where he/she is the owner of the land, he/she will grant an easement to the Cooperative for the purpose of installing poles, lines and all necessary electrical connections. Where the Member is not the owner of the land, the Members agrees to procure the consent of the owner of said property, and where such consent is necessary, the Member agrees to procure the signature of the owner.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available voltages. Service includes lamps, energy from approximately dusk each day until approximately dawn the following day, and maintenance of facilities. The Cooperative will replace all burned-out lamps and will maintain its facilities. Maintenance of outdoor or street lights will normally be performed only during regular business hours and as soon as practical following notification by the member.

The Cooperative will maintain all outdoor or street lights at no cost to the member when failure of such fixture is due to normal failure or action of the elements. Upon determining that a light has been maliciously or intentionally damaged, management may require payment of a Repair Charge, in the amount of \$50.00, by the member of record. The second such occurrence of damage shall require the same Repair Charge and upon the third such occurrence, the Cooperative may elect to remove its lighting facilities and notify the member that lighting facilities are no longer available at or near this location.

The Cooperative, while exercising reasonable diligence at all times to furnish service hereunder, does not guarantee continuous lighting and will not be liable for damages for any interruption, deficiency or failure of service, and reserves the right to interrupt service at any time for necessary repairs to lines or equipment.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to members where the energy used for lighting is through an existing meter. Final determination of applicability rests solely with the Cooperative. All fixtures are for year-round outdoor lighting of yards, driveways, walkways, highways, roads and other areas by highpressure sodium lamps. Fixtures and/or poles will be installed only at locations that are easily and economically accessible to Cooperative equipment and personnel for construction and maintenance.

All outdoor lights should be installed on existing facilities (where possible) or a short extension thereto, in areas where a lighting system is either not provided or is not sufficient to cover the lighting needs of a particular consumer or location. Additional poles will be charged at the rates shown and in the event that additional transformers are needed, the direct cost of the equipment will be paid before construction commences.

Where existing Cooperative-owned poles are deemed not adequate or suitable by either of the parties to this agreement, the Member agrees to furnish an easement for any additional poles required and necessary right of way. The Member agrees to permit any reasonable tree trimming required for service conductors and lighting units or poles. Extensive right of way trimming will be charged at the direct cost to the member and paid before construction commences. The Member agrees that where he/she is the owner of the land, he/she will grant an easement to the Cooperative for the purpose of installing poles, lines and all necessary electrical connections. Where the Member is not the owner of the land, the Member agrees to procure the consent of the owner of said property, and where such consent is necessary, the Member agrees to procure the signature of the owner before construction commences.

MEMBER OWNED DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

In the event that the distribution system on the load side of the meter is owned by the member, the member agrees to grant an easement to GEC for the purpose of installing any additional poles, equipment and fixtures. The member also agrees to provide any permits required by municipal or county agencies. All wiring performed by employees of GEC will be standard installation practices for the purpose of outdoor lighting only. Member also agrees that the outdoor lighting program is a lease program and all fixtures, poles and equipment remains the property of Glades Electric Cooperative.

The Cooperative, while exercising reasonable diligence at all times to furnish service hereunder, does not guarantee continuous lighting and will not be liable for damages for any interruption, deficiency or failure of service, and reserves the right to interrupt service at any time for necessary repairs to lines or equipment.
