As a resident living in unincorporated Seminole County in Longwood, Florida, it my understand that the Public Service Commission *staff's recommendation* is to accept about 80% of the rate increase (\$5.5 million of the \$6.9 million). This rate increase is the unjust and unwarranted. It seems to only benefit the residents in other areas, while residents in my local area are paying for the largest increase. It appears that this rate change is in violation of the Florida Statues 366.06. "...are unjust, unreasonable, unjustly discriminatory, or in violation of law."

It has been may experience that the utility company representing my area has not maintained their equipment and under charged for their services. Once they change my water meter, the water increased by a 100 percent. If these rates area approved, I will be paying an 180% percent increase for water within one year of changing the water meter.
