Since the last increase, I have had several friends that have had a few loads of laundry ruined by this so called quality of water.

We use it for what we have to (laundry, dishes, showers, and toilets), but we get bottles water for everything else, including our dogs drinking water. We don't even water our lawn at all for the simple fact out water bill averages \$115.00 for a family of 4 with 2 dogs – mind you, just for the basics already stated above. That does not include the avg of 10 - 5 gal water jugs we buy/refill each month. If I could actually drink the water, I might not mind the price as much given we do live further out from the city. However, no one is going to drink the same water that bleaches clothes.
