Thank you for contacting the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) about Duke Energy Florida, LLC's (DEF) petition for a proposed 2017 Second Revised and Restated Settlement Agreement (Agreement). To give Commissioners and staff an opportunity to review your concerns, your correspondence is included in the file for Docket No. 20170183-EI.

Included in DEF's proposed Agreement, the utility eliminates the possibility of constructing nuclear reactors in Levy County, outlines several solar-energy projects, and ensures customers stable rates for the coming years. Signatories to the Agreement include Florida's Office of Public Counsel--who represents DEF customers--the Florida Industrial Power Users Group, the Florida Retail Federation, White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Inc. d/b/a PCS Phosphate, and the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy.

The PSC hearing on the Agreement will be on October 25 and can be viewed online at www.floridapsc.com by accessing the camera icon on the homepage. Representatives from the utility and parties to the Agreement will present testimony, and Commissioners will examine the merits of the Agreement: how it will affect DEF's customers and the utility's ability to provide safe and reliable service. A Commission decision is expected by December 2017.
