## ST. JOE NATURAL GAS COMPANY'S PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

St. Joe Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("SJNG") by and through its undersigned officer, hereby submits its Preliminary List of Issues and Positions to be taken up at the Hearing now scheduled to begin October 25, 2017 in the above listed docket.

Issue 1: What are the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts for the period January through December 2016?

SJNG's Position: \$70,123 under-recovery.

Issue 2: What are the appropriate conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up amounts for the period January through December 2017?

SJNG's Position: \$50,917 under-recovery

Issue 3: What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amounts to be collected/refunded from January 2018 through December 2018?

SJNG'S Position: \$50,917 under-recovery

Issue 4: What are the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period January 2018 through December 2018?

SJNG's Position: An Under-recovery of \$189,567.

Issue 5: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2018 through December 2018?

**SJNG's Position:** \$0.44277 per therm for RS-1, \$0.26916 per therm for RS-2, \$.20359 per therm for RS-3, \$.17729 per therm for GS-1,

\$.08111 per therm for GS-2, and \$.03728 per therm for FTS-4.

Issue 4: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

SJNG'S Position: The effective date should be January 1, 2018.
