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2 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Moving on to Item 9 (sic).

3 Good morning.

4 **MS. DRAPER:** Commissioners, if I may introduce
5 a new analyst with the Division of Economics, Riley
6 Doherty, and he is here to introduce Item 8.

7 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Mr. Doherty -- Doherty?

8 **MR. DOHERTY:** Yes, ma'am.

9 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Welcome to the Florida Public
10 Service Commission. How long have you been here?

11 **MR. DOHERTY:** It will be two months in a week.

12 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Oh, well, this is a great
13 forum here for you.

14 **MR. DOHERTY:** Good morning, y'all, or
15 Commissioners and Madam Chairman. Sorry.

16 Item No. 8 is a petition by Tampa Electric
17 Company for a temporary territorial variance at the
18 Mosaic Peacock Mine facility. Currently the facility is
19 in Duke's territory; however, Duke reported it is
20 providing insufficient electricity to the Peacock
21 facility due to additional load at the facility over the
22 year.

23 TECO can provide the necessary electric
24 voltage for the temporary mining at the Peacock facility
25 without decreasing its reliability of electric service

1 to its ratepayers. There's no -- or there has been no
2 customer contact, and staff recommends approval.

3 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Thank you.

4 Commissioner Polmann.

5 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** Good morning,
6 Mr. Doherty.

7 **MR. DOHERTY:** Good morning, sir.

8 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** You had addressed us as
9 "y'all." I appreciate that.

10 **MR. DOHERTY:** You're welcome.

11 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** The key question I
12 would have for you this morning, sir, is can you please
13 explain the difference between y'all, all y'all, and all
14 y'all's?

15 **MR. DOHERTY:** I'm not sure how to decipher the
16 difference between the two.

17 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** Well, I'm terribly
18 disappointed.

19 **MR. DOHERTY:** I will have to get back to you
20 on that one. I'll let you know.

21 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** Well, I'm not from
22 around here, but I do know somebody who's from around
23 here. See, I'm from New Jersey, but I moved to Florida
24 in 1969. And I know somebody who was born in Quincy,
25 and she explained it to me in great detail. So I would

1 appreciate it if you'd get back to me, and that will be
2 your first test.

3 **MR. DOHERTY:** Challenge accepted, sir.

4 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** Can you get -- when
5 will you be getting back to me, sir?

6 **MR. DOHERTY:** By the end of this week -- or
7 tomorrow.

8 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** Well, I would consider
9 by the end of the week to be quite a long time. So if
10 you get back to me by the end of the week, I expect that
11 to be thorough.

12 **MR. DOHERTY:** You'll have references.

13 **COMMISSIONER POLMANN:** Thank you. That's all
14 I have, Madam Chairman.

15 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** He's not joking either.

16 (Laughter.)

17 **MR. DOHERTY:** Okay.

18 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** With that, can I get a motion
19 to approve?

20 **COMMISSIONER GRAHAM:** So move.

21 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Is there a second?

22 **COMMISSIONER BRISÉ:** Second.

23 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Any further discussion or
24 questions?

25 Seeing none, all those in favor, say aye.

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(Vote taken.)

Motion passes. Thank you. And thank you,
Commissioner Polmann.

COMMISSIONER POLMANN: You're welcome.
