PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to the Plan and the Confirmation Order, the deadline for filing requests for payment of Professional Fee Claims shall be <u>45 days</u> <u>after the Effective Date</u>.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to paragraph 143 of the Confirmation Order, <u>Holders of timely-filed Claims</u> may assert a right to payment of post-petition interest in connection therewith by filing a document (the "<u>Post-petition Interest Request</u>") with the Court by <u>February 2, 2018, at 5:00 p.m., prevailing Central Time</u>, requesting payment of post-petition interest.

The Post-petition Interest Request must contain the following information: (i) the requested rate of post-petition interest; (ii) the legal basis for any alleged entitlement of post-petition interest; and (iii) the Debtor against which a right to payment of post-petition interest is asserted, including the individual Debtor's case number. 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
