Pursuant to Order No. 20160101-WS, the allowance for funds prudently invested (AFPI) charges for Lake Utility Services Inc. (LUSI or utility) were discontinued for its Lake Groves' water and wastewater systems and LUSI – Others systems because the Commission determined that the utility exceeded the number of ERCs upon which the AFPI charges were based. Staff was also ordered to open a new docket and conduct an investigation to determine the amount of overcollection of AFPI charges and the disposition of the overcollection. By this letter, Commission staff requests that the utility provide a response to the following data request:

1. Please provide a schedule showing the number of ERCs connected and the amount collected to date, by year since the implementation of the AFPI charges established for LUSI's Lake Groves water and wastewater systems and LUSI - Others systems.

Please respond to staff's data request by February 12, 2018 to allow staff time to appropriately investigate this case.
