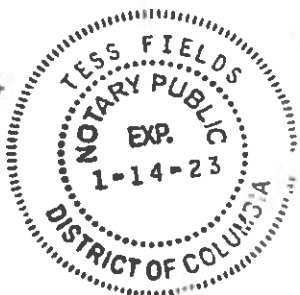
Undersigned counsel is currently a legal fellow of the Sierra Club at the address and telephone number below.
