FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE DECEMBER 2017 EARNINGS SURVEILLANCE REPORT

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes ("Section 366.093"), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby requests confidential classification of certain information contained in the December 2017 Earnings Surveillance Report ("ESR") filed in this proceeding (referred to herein as the "Confidential Information"). In support of this request, FPL states as follows:

1. On February 15, 2018 FPL filed a supplement to its December 2017 Earning Surveillance Report. The Supplemental ESR Schedule "D" has certain portions of the attachments which contain confidential information.

2. The following exhibits are included with this Request:

a. Exhibit A is a copy of the confidential material on which all of the information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted.

b. Exhibit B is a copy of the confidential material on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.

c. Exhibit C is a table that identifies by column and line the information for which confidential treatment is sought and references the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality. Exhibit C also identifies the declarant who support the requested classification.

d. Exhibit D contains the declaration of Tiffany Cohen in support of this request.

3. The Confidential Information is intended to be and has been treated by FPL as private, its confidentiality has been maintained, and its disclosure would cause harm to FPL and its customers. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such materials are entitled to confidential treatment and are exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

4. As described in the declaration in Exhibit D, some of the Confidential Information contains contractual data between FPL and the customer(s) concerning terms of a Contract Service Agreement which are competitive in nature. This information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(d)(e), Fla. Stat.

5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the Confidential Information is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* § 399.093(4), Fla.Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and declaration included herewith, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
