By this letter, Commission staff respectfully request the following information from the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation and Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc.

- 1. Referring to the response to staff's first data request question No. 7, please state when CFG intends to file a petition for a special contract with Ascend Performance Materials?
- 2. Please state whether Ascend Performance Materials is a new load in Escambia County, or an existing customer. If an existing customer, please state where Ascend Performance Materials already receives natural gas and from whom.
- 3. Referring to the response to staff's first data request question No. 10, please state when CFG intends to amend the current tariff sheets to reflect service to Escambia County
- 4. Referring to the response to staff's first data request questions Nos. 3, 7 and 8, please clarify the timing between the construction of the Peninsula Pipeline (third quarter 2018) and service to Ascend Performance Materials/Pensacola Energy (second quarter to 2018). Does the Peninsula Pipeline need to be in operation before service to the customers listed above can begin?
- 5. Referring to the response to staff's first data request question No. 8, please confirm that Pensacola Energy is a municipal natural gas utility that provides natural gas service to residential and commercial customers in the city of Pensacola.

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- 6. Please explain why Pensacola Energy is not directly interconnecting with the proposed Peninsula Pipeline (i.e., why is Chesapeake's distribution system between Pensacola Energy's System and the Peninsula Pipeline)
- 7. Referring to paragraph 11 of the petition, please state when CFG's two distribution systems will be constructed and in operation and how CFG will recover the cost of the construction of the distribution system.
