



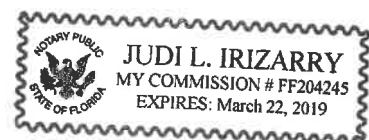

Customers will be given the opportunity to present testimony during the evening session beginning at 6:00 p.m., on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, and at 9:30 a.m., on Wednesday May 16, 2018. Customers' testimony will be a part of the evidence presented in the formal hearing.

Members of the public who wish to present testimony are urged to appear promptly at the scheduled hearing time since the session may be adjourned early if no customers are present.

The purpose of this customer service hearing is to take testimony from the public on the quality and adequacy of K W Resort Utilities Corp.'s service and other matters related to the Utility's petition for a rate increase. The procedure at the customer service hearing shall be as follows: The Utility will present a brief summary of its case and then members of the public may present testimony. All witnesses shall be subject to cross examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

PREHEARING CONFERENCE

A prehearing conference will be held at the following time and place:

The purpose of this prehearing conference is: (1) to define and limit, if possible, the number of issues; (2) to determine the parties' positions on the issues; (3) to determine what facts, if any, may be stipulated; (4) to dispose of any motions or other matters that may be pending; and (5) to consider any other matters that may aid in the disposition of this case.

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE:

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the petition of K W Resort Utilities Corp. for an increase in wastewater rates and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on May 1, 2018. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

JURISDICTION

This Commission is vested with jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding by the provisions of Chapter 367.081, 367.0816, 367.101, and 367.091, Florida Statutes. This proceeding will be governed by Chapter 367 in addition to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-9, 25-22, 25-30, and 28-106, Florida Administrative Code.
