Staff has requested information on the following items to complete the recommendation on time for filing with the June Agenda. As a reminder, staff wishes to reiterate that a fast turnaround on the requested information will help toward making the June Agenda. Please submit the following information to the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Blvd., Tallahassee 32399-0850, by **May 7, 2018**.

1. Rent Expense: In the Staff Report, staff preliminarily recommended allowing the requested \$11,000 in rent expense. To capture a complete and accurate picture of the Utility's appropriate rent expense going forward, please indicate any additional expenses associated with the Utility's home office and provide support documentation for each expense.
2. Insurance Expense: Mr. McBride previously indicated that in lieu of self insurance, the Utility would seek a general liability insurance policy. Please provide support documentation to show that the Utility has obtained a general liability insurance policy. Supporting documents should indicate the effective date, coverage period, and premium associated with the policy.
3. Flushing Valve: Please provide a date for when the flushing valve became active. Did the utility install a meter with the flushing valve, if not why?


