amounts for the period January 2018 through December 2018?

FPL: \$5,074,368 over-recovery. (Deaton)

ISSUE 3: What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amounts to

be collected/refunded from January 2019 through December 2019?

FPL: The total conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amount to be refunded

from January 2019 through December 2019 is \$13,711,769. (Deaton)

ISSUE 4: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during

the period January 2019 through December 2019?

FPL: The total conservation cost recovery amount including prior true-up amounts and

revenues taxes is \$153,423,778. (Sharma)

FPL: Yes. The Commission should approve revised tariffs reflecting the energy conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding. The Commission should direct staff to verify that the revised tariffs are consistent with the Commission's decision. (Deaton)

FPL: This docket is an on-going docket and should remain open.
