D. Basic Position

FPUC has appropriately calculated its true-up amounts and purchased gas adjustment factor as shown in the Company's positions on Issues 1-6 and asks that the Commission approve the Company's proposed PGA Factor for 2019.

E. –G Issues

FPUC's positions on the issues identified for hearing are as follows:

<u>Issue 1:</u> What are the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2017 through December 2017?

<u>FPUC:</u> An over-recovery of \$220,953, inclusive of interest.

<u>Issue 2:</u> What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2018 through December 2018?

<u>FPUC:</u> An over-recovery of \$2,505,604, inclusive of interest.

<u>Issue 3:</u> What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected (refunded) during the period January 2019 through December 2019?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$2,726,557 to be refunded.

<u>Issue 4:</u> What are the levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2019 through December 2019?

FPUC: The appropriate PGA factor is 98.066¢ cents per therm.

<u>Issue 5:</u> What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

FPUC: The factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2019 and should apply for bills rendered for meter readings taken between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019.

Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the new purchased gas adjustment charges determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?

FPUC: Yes. The Commission should approve revised tariffs reflecting the new purchased gas adjustment charges determined to be appropriate in this proceeding. The Commission should direct staff to verify that the revised tariffs are consistent with the Commission's decision.

G. Stipulated Issues

While not a party to stipulations at this time, FPUC believes that it should be possible to reach a stipulation on each of the issues as they pertain to FPUC.
