1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Item No. 10.
3	MR. WILSON: Good morning, Commissioners.
4	Kordell Wilson with Commission staff.
5	Pine Harbour Waterworks, Inc., is a Class C
6	utility serving approximately 62 residential and
7	two general-service water customers in Lake County.
8	On January 23rd, 2018, Pine Harbour filed an
9	application for a staff-assisted rate case. The
10	utility has been under Commission jurisdiction
11	since 1985 when it was granted Certificate No.
12	450-W.
13	The utility's ownership subsequently changed
14	in 1991, 2008, and 2017. It has never had a rate
15	case, but received approval to charge miscellaneous
16	service charges in a 2009 tariff filing and in the
17	2016 transfer docket. According to the utility's
18	2017 annual report, total gross revenues were
19	\$23,286, and total operating expenses were \$26,383,
20	resulting in a net operating loss of \$3,097.
21	Today, staff is recommending a revenue
22	requirement of \$34,292, resulting in an annual
23	increase of 43.56 percent.
24	Mr. Troy Rendell is here on behalf of the
25	utility. And at this time, staff is prepared to

1	answer any questions.
2	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, staff.
3	Mr. Rendell?
4	MR. RENDELL: Commissioners, Troy Rendell on
5	behalf of Pine Pine Harbour Waterworks.
6	Overall, I support staff's recommendation.
7	I do want to make one point on one issue.
8	It's the excess of unaccounted-for water. I have
9	supplied supporting documentation showing that
10	after we replaced approximately 43 meters
11	throughout the system, we went back and we realized
12	there is a leak at the ground storage tank.
13	When we put those numbers back in, those
14	numbers actually are are have been lowered;
15	although, you know, it's not a major dollar impact
16	to the case. I just want to let the staff the
17	Commission know that we have went back and looked
18	at what's transpired after the replacement of those
19	meters, and it has gone down.
20	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, sir.
21	Commissioner Polmann.
22	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Thank you,
23	Mr. Chairman.
24	Mr. Rendell, could you elaborate a little bit
25	on the on the leak? Is that something you found

1	and have repaired? Is that something you plan to
2	repair? What's the issue there?
3	MR. RENDELL: Actually, the entire aeration
4	and the ground storage tank is going to have to be
5	replaced. It's going to have to go to something
6	similar to Country Walk, but we realize it's going
7	to be a major financial impact. DEP just did an
8	inspection and we're looking at basically, it
9	doesn't make sense to repair it's a small leak
10	that comes out it's a concrete-block ground
11	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Okay.
12	MR. RENDELL: storage tank, and the
13	aeration is just a simple aeration where it blows
14	out of tubing. The entire thing needs to be
15	replaced. And we've discussed this with staff and
16	we're letting DEP know, but that's something that's
17	probably going to have to be done in the future,
18	but we realize this is the first rate case and it's
19	going to be something that we're going to have to
20	address pretty soon in the future.
21	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Thank you.
22	Staff, has there been an adjustment in the
23	material we have here? Or is that in terms of
24	the unaccounted-for water? Can you bring us up to

date?

1	Oh, you again.
2	(Laughter.)
3	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Did you get the answer?
4	MR. SALVADOR: Luis Salvador for staff.
5	The excessive unaccounted-for water is based
6	on the meter, the distribution meter
7	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Okay.
8	MR. SALVADOR: that it was found to be
9	inaccurate or it was missing 14.7 percent. And
10	because the meter was not registering the amount of
11	water, when we did the calculation, we find out
12	that there was an excess of unaccounted-for water.
13	It is not related to the crack on the water tank.
14	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Okay. All right.
15	Thank you for that answer.
16	MR. SALVADOR: You're welcome.
17	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Did you get my other
18	answer yet?
19	MR. SALVADOR: No not yet, but I will get
20	it for you.
21	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Okay. Thank you.
22	MR. SALVADOR: Thank you, Commissioner
23	Polmann.
24	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commissioners, any other
25	questions on this item, Item No. 10? I'll

1	entertain a motion.
2	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Mr. Chairman, I would
3	move approval on all issues.
4	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and
5	seconded, staff recommendation on all issues on
6	Item No. 10. Any further discussion?
7	Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.
8	(Chorus of ayes.)
9	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any opposed?
10	By your action, you have approved staff
11	recommendation on all issues on Item No. 10.
