1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Item No. 6.

3 MR. BARRETT: Good morning, Commissioners.
4 Michael Barrett with staff.

5 Item 6 is a post-hearing recommendation in the
6 Fuel Cost Recovery Clause docket. In early
7 November, the annual hearing for this docket was
8 held. And at that time, many issues for Florida
9 Power & Light Company and the other investor-owned
10 utilities were approved by bench decisions.

11 This recommendation addresses the six issues
12 that were not resolved by bench decisions, all of
13 these issues which pertain to Florida Power &
14 Light's solar-generation base-rate-adjustment
15 considerations.

16 Staff is not aware of any customer comments
17 that have been filed in this docket. We're
18 available for your questions, and we recommend
19 approval for all items in Issue 6.

20 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Well, I would be surprised
21 if you did not recommend approval.

22 (Laughter.)

23 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commissioners, any questions
24 of staff for Item No. 6?

25 Commissioner Brown.

1 COMMISSIONER BROWN: I -- I don't have any
2 questions, but I do just want to point out -- and
3 we've got an opportunity to delve into some of
4 these issues that we probably could have made by a
5 bench decision, but it is important to note that
6 the proposed SoBRA for 2019 is projected to fall
7 well below the cap and produce savings and other
8 benefits for customers. And so, this is -- this is
9 a good thing. And I support the recommendation in
10 full.

11 And with that, I move approval on all issues.

12 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Second.

13 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and second,
14 approval of all issues on Item No. 6. Any further
15 discussion?

16 Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.

17 (Chorus of ayes.)

18 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any opposed?

19 By your actions, you've approved staff
20 recommendation Item No. 6.
